The PCCCF Free Medical Clinic

The PCCCF Free Medical Clinic has provided medical care for more than 1,800 under- and uninsured people—who have visited the Clinic nearly 4,000 times—since October of 2000. The Clinic serves low-income and disadvantaged people regardless of race, age, gender, religion, residency, employment or immigration status. Services and medications are provided to all absolutely free.

The Clinic operates two Saturday mornings a month, and offers basic medical treatment, immunizations,

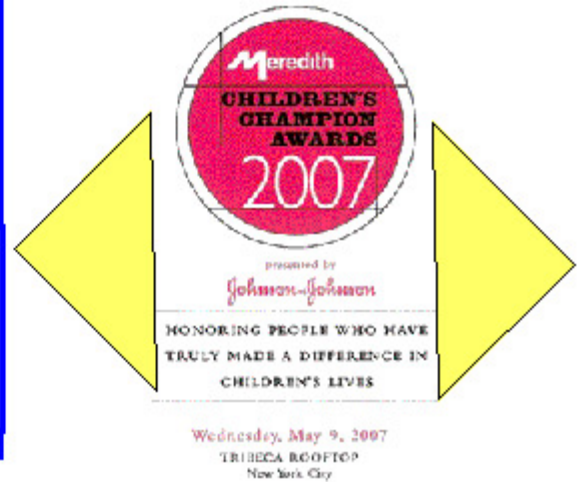
The PCCCF Clinic provides the following services, completely free of charge:

- Well baby and child exams, including immunizations to age 18
- Day care/school/sports/camp physicals
- Pre-employment exams, including TB skin testing
- General exams for adults
- Blood pressure checks
- Screenings for cholesterol, blood glucose, anemia, and strep
- Vision and hearing screens
- Laboratory and radiology tests as needed
- Flu shots
- Free medications available in our formulary

- The Clinic does NOT provide:
- Prenatal or OB/GYN services
 - Psychiatric counseling
 - Immigration physicals
 - Prescription of controlled medications and "lifestyle" drugs, such as Viagra or Propecia
 - Weight loss programs
 - Workman's compensation exams

A minimum of two licensed physicians are always present during clinic hours. For more information about the Clinic, call (414) 342-1400.
